On 12/28/72, [redacted] and [redacted], Intelligence Division, Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D. C. (WDC), advised that during the annual meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), parts of which were held at the Shoreham Hotel and the Sheraton Park Hotel in WDC, the directors of AAAS tried unsuccessfully on 12/26/72 to prevent representatives of SESPA from setting up a literature table in the AAAS registration area of the Shoreham Hotel. The SESPA literature called both American science and the AAAS tools of corporate interests that rule America.

On 12/27/72, eight arrests were made when members of SESPA refused to move their literature from the AAAS registration area at the Sheraton Park Hotel.

"The Washington Post" newspaper, 12/28/72 issue, in an article captioned "Violence Disrupts AAAS Session On Violence," listed the following individuals as having been arrested on 12/27/72 at the Sheraton Park Hotel:
