Boston is authorized to disseminate referenced report to the Army, Navy and Air Force locally. Boston is instructed to closely follow the activities of this organization and advise the Bureau and WFO of the plans of captioned organization to demonstrate at the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Convention in Washington, D.C., on 12/26-31/72.

Chicago determine if the Science for Vietnam Project functions as a Scientists and Engineers for Social and Political Action (SESPA) chapter or as a separate organization affiliated with SESPA merely to promote its own aims and goals. If the latter, investigate and report its activities as a separate organization. Chicago advise Boston, WFO and the Bureau of any plans by Science for Vietnam Project to disrupt the forthcoming AAAS Convention.
