VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR VALLEY FORGE II MADE UP
LARGELY OF ATTENDEES AT AMERICAN ASSOCIATION FOR THE
ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE (AAAS) CONVENTION IN PHILADELPHIA
IN FRONT OF SHERATON MOTOR INN, SEVENTH AND J.F.K.
BOULEVARD, PHILADELPHIA, BETWEEN ELEVEN A.M. AND ELEVEN
THIRTY A.M. APPROXIMATELY TWENTYFIVE INDIVIDUALS REPRESENTING
VVAW WERE INCLUDED. SIGNS WERE DISPLAYED URGING END
TO UNITED STATES INVOLVEMENT IN VIETNAM. LIBERATING SCIENCE
FOR THE PEOPLE, AND ADVISING THAT SHERATON MOTOR INN IS
OWNED BY INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH (I T AND T).
GROUP THEN MARCHED TO INDEPENDANCE HALL, PHILADELPHIA,
WHERE APPROXIMATELY FIFTY VVAW INDIVIDUALS, OBSERVED BY SAS
OF THE FBI, HAD BEEN IN PROCESS OF SETTING UP LOUD SPEAKING
SYSTEM AND REPLICA OF LIBERTY BELL BETWEEN ELEVEN A.M.
AND NOON. WHEN GROUP COMING FROM SHERATON DENOUNCING UNITED
STATES ACTIONS IN VIETNAM. REPRESENTATIVES OF GROUPS ARRESTED
AT LINCOLN MEMORIAL, WASHINGTON, D.C., TWELVE TWENTYEIGHT
LAST, BETSY ROSS HOUSE, PHILADELPHIA, TWELVE TWENTYEIGHT

LAST, AND STATUE OF LIBERTY, SPOKE GIVING THEIR PURPOSES FOR THEIR ACTIONS. IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT TWELVE THIRTY NEXT WILLIAM BUNDY WOULD ADDRESS AAAS CONVENTION, NINE A.M., SHERATON MOTOR INN, SEVENTEENTH AND J.F.K. BOULEVARD, PHILADELPHIA, IN HALL OF FLAGS ROOM. IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT BUNDY WILL BE CONFRONTED IN SAME MANNER AS WAS SENATOR HUBERT H. HUNPHREY TWELVE TWENTYSEVEN LAST AND WILL BE REQUESTED TO ANSWER CHARGES OF WAR CRIMES. IT WAS ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT SIXTEEN VVAW MEMBERS HAD OCCUPIED SOUTH VIETNAM CONSULS OFFICE, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA, INSTANT DATE, AND LYNDON BAINES JOHNSON LIBRARY, TEXAS, INSTANT DATE. IT WAS ALSO ANNOUNCED THERE WILL BE AN ANTI -WAR RALLY, WEST RITTENHOUSE SQUARE, PHILADELPHIA, TWELVE NOON, TWELVE THIRTY NEXT. AFTER RALLY AT INDEPENDENCE HALL, MARCHERS WALKED DOWN MARKET STREET TO PHILADELPHIA CITY HALL, AND RETURNED TO INDEPENDENCE HALL VIA CHESTNUT STREET UNDER POLICE ESCORT. MARCHERS THEN PROCEEDED TO FRIENDS MEETING HOUSE, FOURTH AND ARCH STREETS, PHILADELPHIA, WHERE THEY WERE TO AWAIT ARRIVAL OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD BEEN
