SPOKESMEN FOR THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT (MPD), WASHINGTON, D. C., FURNISHED THE FOLLOWING REGARDING INCIDENTS AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE(AAAS), SHOREHAM HOTEL, WDC.

THE AD HOC COMMITTEE OF CONCERNED SCIENTISTS RECEIVED A PERMIT TO DEMONSTRATE FROM NOON UNTIL THREE PM, DECEMBER TWENTYEIGHT, NINETEEN SEVENTY TWO, AT CONNECTICUT AVENUE AND CALVERT STREET, NW, ADJACENT TO THE SHOREHAM HOTEL.

THE APPLICATION WAS FILED BY [REDACTED] A WDC ANTI-WAR ACTIVIST, AND THE SPONSOR WAS LISTED AS [REDACTED] NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED.

ON DECEMBER TWENTYEIGHT, NINETEEN SEVENTYTWO,
TWO HUNDRED TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY INDIVIDUALS
DISTRIBUTED LEAFLETS AT THE ABOVE LOCATION FROM NOON UNTIL
ONE FORTY PM. THERE WERE NO INCIDENTS OR ARRESTS.

ON DECEMBER TWENTYSIX NINETEEN SEVENTYTWO, THE DIRECTORS OF
AAAS TRIED UNSUCCESSFULLY TO PREVENT REPRESENTATIVES OF
SESPA FROM SETTING UP A LITERATURE TABLE IN THE AAAS REGISTRATION
AREA OF THE SHOREHAM HOTEL. THIS LITERATURE CALLED BOTH
AMERICAN SCIENCE AND THE AAAS TOOLS OF CORPORATE INTERESTS
THAT RULE AMERICA. A SPOKESMAN FOR SESPA WAS IDENTIFIED
AS .

SEVEN ARRESTS WERE MADE ON DECEMBER TWENTYSEVEN
NINETEEN SEVENTYTWO WHEN THE SESPA REFUSED TO MOVE THEIR
LITERATURE TABLE FROM THE AAAS AREA. WAS ONE OF
THOSE ARRESTED.
