BETWEEN NINE A.M., AND ELEVEN FORTY FIVE INSTANT DATE, WILLIAM BUNDY, FORMER UNDERSECRETARY OF STATE UNDER THE JOHNSON ADMINISTRATION, SPOKE TO APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED TO ONE TWENTYFIVE PEOPLE REPRESENTING AAAS, SCIENTISTS AND ENGINEERS FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL ACTION (SESPA) AND APPROXIMATELY TWENTY TO THIRTY MEMBERS OF VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR (VVAW) AT HALL OF FLAGS, SHERATON HOTEL, PHILADELPHIA, PA. SA OF FBI OBSERVED SPEECH. ST-106

BUNDY SPOKE FOR APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR ON VARIOUS ASPECTS OF VIETNAM. SPEECH WAS INTERRUPTED AT VARIOUS TIMES BY SHOUTS OF OBSCENITIES AND ARGUMENTS BY THE MEMBERS OF AAAS, SESPA, AND VVAW. INDIVIDUALS REPRESENTING SESPA AND VVAW OUTNUMBERED MEMBERS OF AAAS AND DEFINITELY CONTROLLED. THE LAST HOUR OF THE CONFERENCE, WAS DEVOTED TO A QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION WITH QUESTIONS DIRECTED TO MR. BUNDY.

MR. GLEB, AAAS COORDINATOR, ATTEMPTED TO LET MEMBERS OF AAAS, SESPA, AND VVAW ASK BUNDY ALTERNATING QUESTIONS, THE ALTERNATING SESSION FAILED AND MOST OF THE QUESTIONS DIRECTED TO BUNDY WERE ASKED BY MEMBERS OF SESPA AND VVAW.

APPROXIMATELY ELEVEN TEN A.M., INSTANT DATE MR. GELB UNPLUGGED PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM AND ANNOUNCED MEETING WAS OVER. BUNDY AND GELB/ EXITED THE CONFERENCE ROOM WITHOUT INCIDENT AND NO ARRESTS WERE MADE.
