 GROUP FROM COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY SESPA WOULD TRAVEL TO MASSACHUSETTS  
 INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (MIT) ON JANUARY EIGHT, NEXT, TO PROTEST  
 UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT SPONSORED MILITARY RESEARCH BEING  
 CONDUCTED ON CAMPUS. THE GROUP WILL BE LED BY PROFESSOR  
 SEYMOUR MELMAN OF THE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AT COLUMBIA. AT
