and Philadelphia letter to Bureau dated 3/28/72.

Information previously received by the Philadelphia
Division listed one [redacted] from the University
of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Pa., as a contact for captioned
organization.

The Philadelphia Division has verified that [redacted]
[redacted] is an Assistant Professor, Anatomy - Chemistry
Department, University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Pa.,
but has been unable to establish that there is an active chapter
of SESPA at the University of Pennsylvania.

On 6/15/72, [redacted] (SIO), who is familiar with the
activities on the University of Pennsylvania campus advised
he is not aware of any organized chapter of SESPA or splinter groups
calling themselves SESPA operating on the campus.

During April and May of 1972, [redacted]
[redacted] all reliable confidential informants who are
familiar with revolutionary activities in the Philadelphia
area furnished negative information concerning [redacted]
[redacted] and SESPA.
