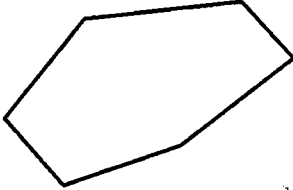

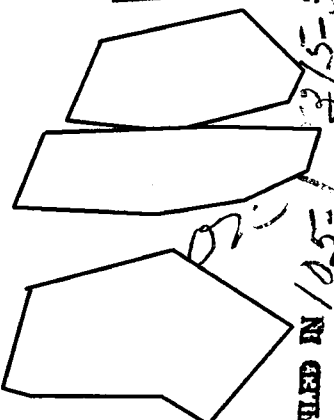

ON MAY TWO, INSTANT, A SOURCE WITH WHOM THERE HAS BEEN INSUFFICIENT CONTACT TO DETERMINE RELIABILITY OF HIS INFORMATION, ADVISED HE LEARNED DEMONSTRATION SCHEDULED TO BE HELD AT COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS, SIXTY EIGHT STREET AND PARK AVENUE, NEW YORK, NEW YORK, FROM ELEVEN O'CLOCK AM TO FIVE O'CLOCK PM ON INSTANT DATE WAS NOT BEING SPONSORED BY SESPA BUT THE SOCIAL SCIENTISTS FOR PEACE NOW (SSFPN), AN AD HOC GROUP OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY STUDENTS.

ON MAY TWO, INSTANT, SPECIAL AGENTS OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OBSERVED PICKET LINE DEMONSTRATION ON NORTH WEST CORNER OF SIXTY EIGHT STREET AND PARK AVENUE, NEW YORK, NEW YORK, FROM ELEVEN FORTY AM UNTIL FOUR THIRTY PM. TEN INDIVIDUALS PARTICIPATED IN DEMONSTRATION AND CARRIED SUCH SIGNS AS " THE COUNCIL WHISPERS, NIXONS KILLS", NIXON'S PEACE PLAN IS BOMB" AND CFR, THINK TANK FOR VIETNAM".

DEMONSTRATORS PASSED OUT STATEMENT SIGNED " COLUMBIA'S SOCIAL SCIENTISTS FOR PEACE NOW" WHICH URGED MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS LOCATED AT FIFTY EIGHT EAST SIXTY EIGHT STREET, NEW YORK, NEW YORK, TO PUBLIC^{ALLY} DENOUNCE PRESIDENT NIXON'S ADMINISTRATION FROM ITS "INSANE " CONTINUATION OF THE INDOCHINA CONFLICT AND TO UTILIZE THEIR PRIVATE RESOURCES, AS WELL AS THE RESOURCES OF ~~THE~~ THE COUNCIL ITSELF, TO GET THE UNITED STATES OUT OF INDOCHINA NOW.
