IN THE PAST, ADVISED ON INSTANT DATE, THAT SCIENTISTS AND ENGINEERS FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL ACTION (SESPA), WILL LEAVE THE SHERATON PARK HOTEL, WASHINGTON, D.C., AT TWELVE NOON ON APRIL TWENTYNINE, NEXT, AND TAKE A BUS TO THE JEFFERSON MEMORIAL WHERE THEY WILL REGROUP AND MARCH TO THE PENTAGON. AT THE PENTAGON, THEY INTEND
