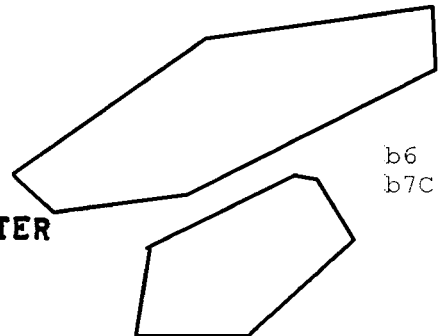

THE SAME SOURCE ADVISED SESPA HEADQUARTERS  
RESPONDED WITH A LETTER TO BEREAND AS FOLLOWS:

"WE WERE ALL FREAKED OUT TO SEE IT (THE  
NEWSLETTER). THE TOPICS TO BE DISCUSSED ARE  
INCREDIBLE, THE INFO GIVEN OUT WILL BE ABSOLUTELY  
DYNAMITE . . . . . I THINK IT IS ABSOLUTELY  
NECESSARY THAT WE FIND OUT WHAT IS HAPPENING INSIDE  
THAT MEETING. THE INFO IS PROBABLY NOT CLASSIFIED  
PER SE BUT IMPOSSIBLE TO OBTAIN BY ASKING . . . . .  
ASIDE FROM OUR FINDING OUT THE WEAK SPOTS IN THE  
SYSTEM, IT IS VITAL FOR US TO UNDERSTAND THE  
EXTENT TO WHICH THEY ARE WORKING TO COUNTERACT  
SUBVERSION; THE TACTICS THEY ARE DEVELOPING, AND  
THEIR WHOLE APPROACH - STRATEGY - TO CONTROLLING  
PEOPLE IN AN OPPRESSIVE SYSTEM . . . . .  
WHILE IT WOULD BE VERY IRONIC FOR THIS CONFERENCE  
TO BE SUBVERTED - DISRUPTED. WE THINK IT WOULD  
BE BETTER FOR US TO GET THE INFO OUT OF THERE.  
HOPEFULLY A FULL RECORDING. MINIMALLY, THE  
PEOPLE ATTENDING AND WHAT EXACTLY THEY ARE INTO."

SOURCE ADVISED THAT SESPA HAS NOT FURTHER  
CORRESPONDED WITH [REDACTED] BUT IT IS KNOWN THAT  
[REDACTED] OF THE ITHACA AREA WAS TO  
CONTACT [REDACTED] AND TRY TO CONVINCHE HIM TO  
ATTEND THIS ENGINEERING FOUNDATION CONFERENCE  
AND RECORD THE ENTIRE CONFERENCE IF POSSIBLE.

THE SAME SOURCE INDICATED ON  
NOVEMBER THIRTY SEVENTYONE THAT SCIENTISTS AND ENGINEERS  
FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL ACTION (SESPA) IS A NATIONAL  
ORGANIZATION OF PERSONS INVOLVED IN SCIENTIFIC OR  
ENGINEERING FIELDS. THIS ORGANIZATION WAS  
FORMERLY KNOWN AS SCIENTISTS FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL  
ACTION AND NOW IS NORMALLY REFERRED TO AS SESPA.  
SESPA IS A LOOSELY KNIT NATIONAL GROUP WHICH ORGANIZES  
IN CHAPTERS LOCATED IN VARIOUS CITIES IN THE UNITED  
STATES. EACH CHAPTER HAS ITS OWN NAME AND OPERATES  
INDEPENDENTLY FROM OTHER CHAPTERS. SESPA PRODUCES  
ITS OWN NATIONAL MAGAZINE KNOWN AS "SCIENCE FOR THE  
PEOPLE." SESPA ON A NATIONAL BASIS PARTICIPATES  
IN THREE TYPES OF ACTIVITIES: ONE. THE PUBLICATION
