In May, 1972, it was reported that an unmarked piece of luggage had arrived at the International Airport, Salt Lake City, Utah, containing various scientific papers and other materials addressed to organizations and individuals in North Vietnam which had been prepared by collectives of "Science for Vietnam in the U.S." (u)

On June 12, 1972, a source who has not been sufficiently contacted in the past to determine his reliability, advised that a claim for the above mentioned luggage had been filed by [Redacted] (u)
[Redacted], Chicago, Illinois.

In filing his claim, [Redacted] stated that on May 24, 1972, he had taken a United Airlines Flight 464 from O'Hare International Airport to New York City and on that same date had taken Pan American Airways Flight 002 from Kennedy International Airport, New York, to Bangkok, Thailand. On May 26, 1972, he left Bangkok via Thai Airways Flight 525 to Vientiane (Laos). (u)

Source stated that [Redacted] has now returned to Chicago but the route of his return is unknown. [Redacted] (u)
[Redacted] gave as the purpose of his travel that it was a "medical mission".

The CPUSA set up committees for the defense of Angela Davis, a self-admitted CPUSA member, in October, 1970. The CPUSA in Illinois has consistently supported the Chicago Angela Davis Defense Committee and been instrumental in its direction.

On 5/3/72, [REDACTED] advised he was unaware of subject's employment at Northeastern University, Boston, Massachusetts. [REDACTED] advised, if subject was employed by the university, he was not known to be a radical on Northeastern campus.

On 5/25/72, a source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised subject was not known to be a radical on the campus of Northeastern University. Source stated he would attempt to determine if subject was employed by the university.

On 6/7/72, this same source advised [REDACTED] is employed by Northeastern University on its Boston campus as a lecturer in Economics. [REDACTED] is employed by the University College, which is Northeastern's night school.

Northeastern records indicate subject resides at [REDACTED] Mass. [REDACTED]

For the information of the Bureau, investigation conducted in this case, as well as in the case of [REDACTED] (aka, [REDACTED]), SM-SDS, has revealed that [REDACTED] is the son of subject, [REDACTED] has been reportedly active in SDS/WSA affairs at Boston, Mass., for approximately one year.

Subject continues to reside at [redacted] above the offices of the Scientists and Engineers for Social and Political Action group. Subject continues to be the dominant person in this group and controls this group through his control of its national magazine "Science for the People."

In view of the fact that subject is now known to be employed as a lecturer at Northeastern University, Boston, authority is, therefore, sought to continue security investigation of subject. It is noted that the source mentioned above advised that subject is not a full-time lecturer at Northeastern but is a part-time employee paid by the number of classes he teaches.
