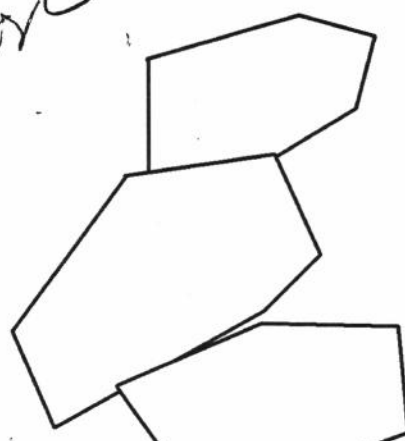

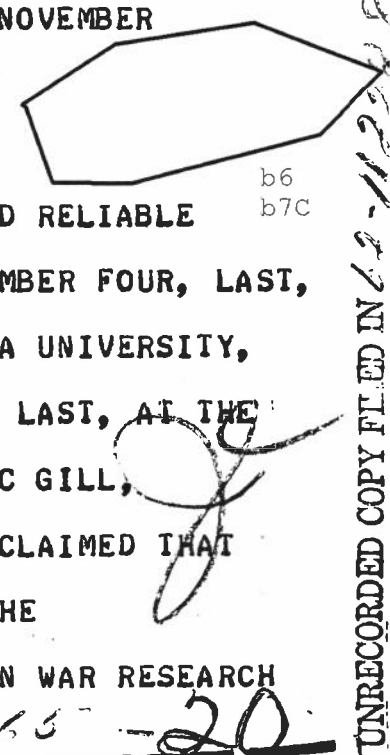

FOUR, SEVENTY ONE, IS-NEW LEFT; STAG.

ON NOVEMBER FOUR, LAST, A SOURCE, WHO HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE
INFORMATION IN THE PAST, ADVISED THAT IN THE AM OF NOVEMBER FOUR, LAST,
LEAFLETS WERE DISTRIBUTED BY SESPA ON CAMPUS OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY,
NYC, CALLING FOR A NOON DEMONSTRATION ON NOVEMBER FOUR, LAST, AT THE
RESIDENCE OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT WILLIAM J. MC GILL,
MORNINGSIDE DRIVE AT ONE HUNDRED SIXTEEN STREET. SESPA CLAIMED THAT
COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY WAS STILL SECRETLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE
RIVERSIDE RESEARCH INSTITUTE AND THEREFORE ASSISTING IN WAR RESEARCH
FOR THE PENTAGON.
