A source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on January 4, 1972 that at approximately 5:30 p.m. on December 22, 1971, a demonstration protesting the Riverside Research Institute's involvement in the Department of Defense research was held in front of the Riverside Research Institute, 80 West End Avenue, New York, New York (NY), under the auspices of Scientists and Engineers for Social and Political Action (SESPA) a Columbia University-based organization headed by [redacted].
