ReNHlet to Bureau 3/24/72.

On 3/21/72 the Connecticut Daily Campus, daily student newspaper for the campus of the University of Connecticut (UConn), Storrs, Connecticut, carried an advertisement for a meeting for all those interested in forming a SESPA chapter at UConn. The above newspaper also carried an advertisement on 4/5, 6 and 10/72 for a meeting to be held on 4/10/72. On 4/11/72 Detective [redacted], UConn Police Department, advised that approximately twelve unidentified persons attended the 4/10/72 meeting. [redacted] could provide no further information re this meeting.

On May 30, 1972, [redacted] advised that no further meetings were held after the one on 4/10/72 and stated that it was not likely that any meetings would be held during the summer months.

On 9/22/72 [redacted] advised that captioned group held no meetings during the summer school sessions at UConn. He stated that he had seen no advertisements or announcements around the campus during the summer. [redacted] further advised that since the resumption of the 1972 Fall semester the Connecticut Daily Campus has carried no advertisements for the captioned group's meetings.

On 9/22/72 a source in a position to know, advised that captioned organization has not yet registered on campus. Source further advised that for any group to use campus facilities to hold meetings, a registration form has to be submitted. Source advised that not all groups have yet registered and that the information would be obtainable when and if captioned group does register.
