On August 1, 1969, a source who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that a meeting of the Washington Area Free University (WAFU) was held at 1854 Park Road, N. W., Washington, D. C. (WDC) on the evening of July 29, 1969. Among the more than 30 persons who attended this meeting was [Redacted], Maryland, telephone [Redacted].

A letter dated October 26, 1968, from the WAFU, Box 9626, WDC 20016, states in part: "The Free University system is not new. Its intentions are often broad as well as vague. Its structure is not physical, yet it is capable of bringing people together to learn more about life through the means of interpersonal group education for anyone who chooses to register for the courses The Washington Area Free University seeks to offer a forum for experience and expression, a catalyst for social interaction and communication. Our teachers are Everyman--our students are disciples of wonder".

The source reported on August 14, 1969, that an attendance sheet of the WAFU observed on August 13, 1969, indicated that [Redacted], telephone number [Redacted], had attended a WAFU meeting on July 23, 1969.

An advertisement appearing in the June 25, 1969, issue, page A-11, of "The Washington Post," a WDC daily newspaper, contained the heading, "MR. PRESIDENT: END THE WAR NOW!" and was sponsored by "End The War Ad Hoc Committee, P. O. Box 1314, Silver Spring, Maryland 20902." The Signers of this ad urged the following as the road to peace:

1. Halt all offensive military operations in Vietnam, including search and destroy missions.
2. Commit ourselves to withdrawal of all our troops within one year, and begin withdrawal immediately.

An "Economics Priorities Report" dated April, 1970, published by the Council on Economic Priorities, 1028 Connecticut Avenue, N. W., WDC, lists on page 2 the name of [REDACTED], under "Fellows of the Council".

The Council on Economic Priorities is self-described as a non-profit information and research center established to disseminate unbiased and detailed information on the practices of U. S. corporations in four major areas: employment, effects on environment, defense production and foreign investment.

The files of The Credit Bureau, Incorporated, WDC, the U. S. Park Police, WDC, and the Montgomery County Maryland, Police Department, when checked on July 10, 1972, contained no record identifiable with [REDACTED].

Files of the Metropolitan Police Department, WDC, as of July 10, 1972, contained the following information concerning one [REDACTED], who may be identical with the subject:

On October 7, 1968, [Redacted] made application for a D. C. motor vehicle operator's permit in which he listed his address as [Redacted] Washington [Redacted] but requested that the permit be mailed to [Redacted] Arlington, Virginia 22209. He stated he held a valid operator's permit issued by the state of California.
